You've heard of Crohn's disease, cystic fibrosis, multiple sclerosis, and Parkinson's disease. **Have you heard of Celiac Disease?**

Celiac Disease affects more people than all of these disorders *combined*. Celiac disease affects 1% of the population worldwide—children, adults, men and women. Yet **97%** of people with Celiac Disease go **undiagnosed**.

Celiac Disease is one of the most common genetic conditions in the world. Celiac disease is a multi-symptom, multi-system disorder, activated by eating gluten—proteins found in wheat, rye and barley. Symptoms vary and are not always gastrointestinal. Be aware of presenting symptoms of Celiac Disease. Identify patients at high risk. Be familiar with screening tests. Understand the importance of follow-up. If you think your patient may have celiac disease, proper diagnosis and treatment are essential.
